PatchAmp has introduced the PA6400A audio distribution frame.

Finally an audio da tray that can be wired quickly and easily. This new system eliminates such common problems as loose screws, frayed wires, connectors popping off, miss-wiring, shorts, bad grounds, ac hum, the list goes on and on.



Analog

PatchAmp is the the first to offer an Elco 3 pin backplane on an audio da tray. This connector allows the wireman to terminate the red/black/shields completely prior to bringing the wire to the frame, once the wire is prepped the connector housing snaps onto the tray. Any combination of AES or Analog distribution amplifiers can be mixed in the same frame. The frame can hold 16 cards, each card can be set to be either (4) 1-in 4-out da's or (2)1-in 9-out da's or (1) 1-in 9 out and (2) 1-in 4-out da's.
